

7. NATIONAL INTEGRATION DAY








This was followed with a speech by the Principal, wherein she inspired all the staff members and students to be sincere and honest with their dealings, committed and loyal towards their work.






"THE PICTURE PITCH" THEME - ONLY ONE EARTH ON WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY 5th June' 2022

11.WORLD AIDS DAY








12.HUMAN RIGHTS DAY
