The college is in its 65th year of serving the nation and provides quality higher education to women, as a full-fledged Autonomous 'A+' Grade college affiliated to Maharishi Dayanand Saraswati University, Ajmer. The College offers the following courses- **Bachelors** of Arts, Science, Commerce, Management, Computer Application, Library and Information Science (as per NEP 2020); **Post Graduation** in English Literature, Geography, History, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, History, Chemistry, Computer Science and Commerce (ABST) and **Doctorate** in Geography, History, Chemistry, Computer Science and Commerce.

The IQAC members formulated a team and started documenting and preparing for the AISHE and NIRF Ranking and AQAR reports.

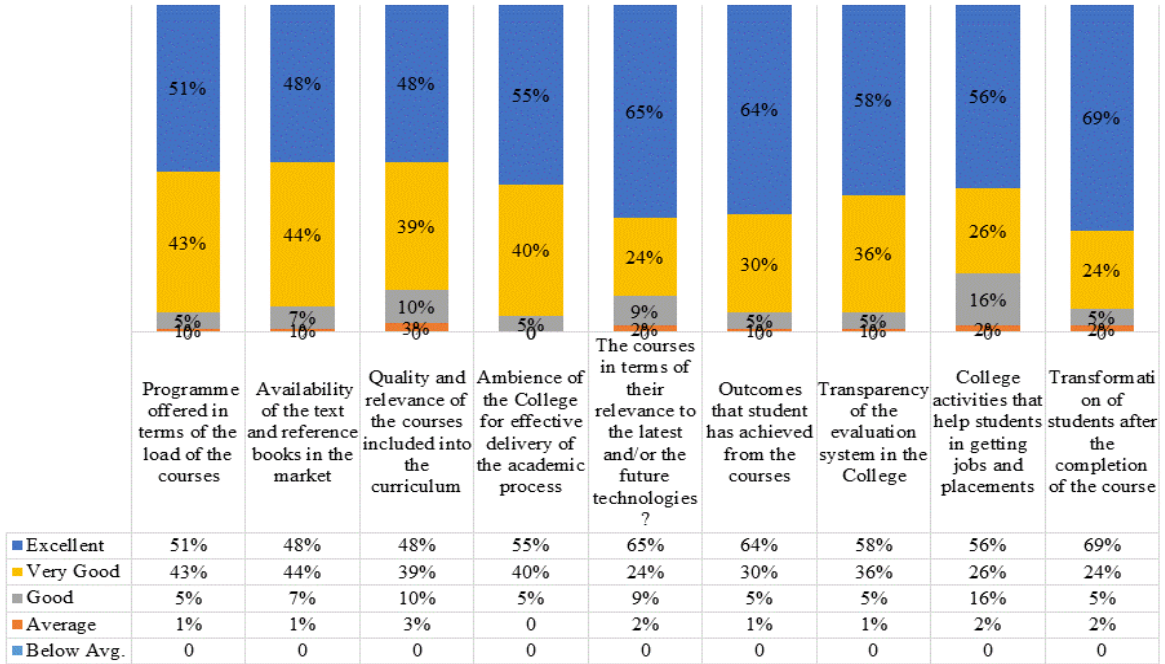

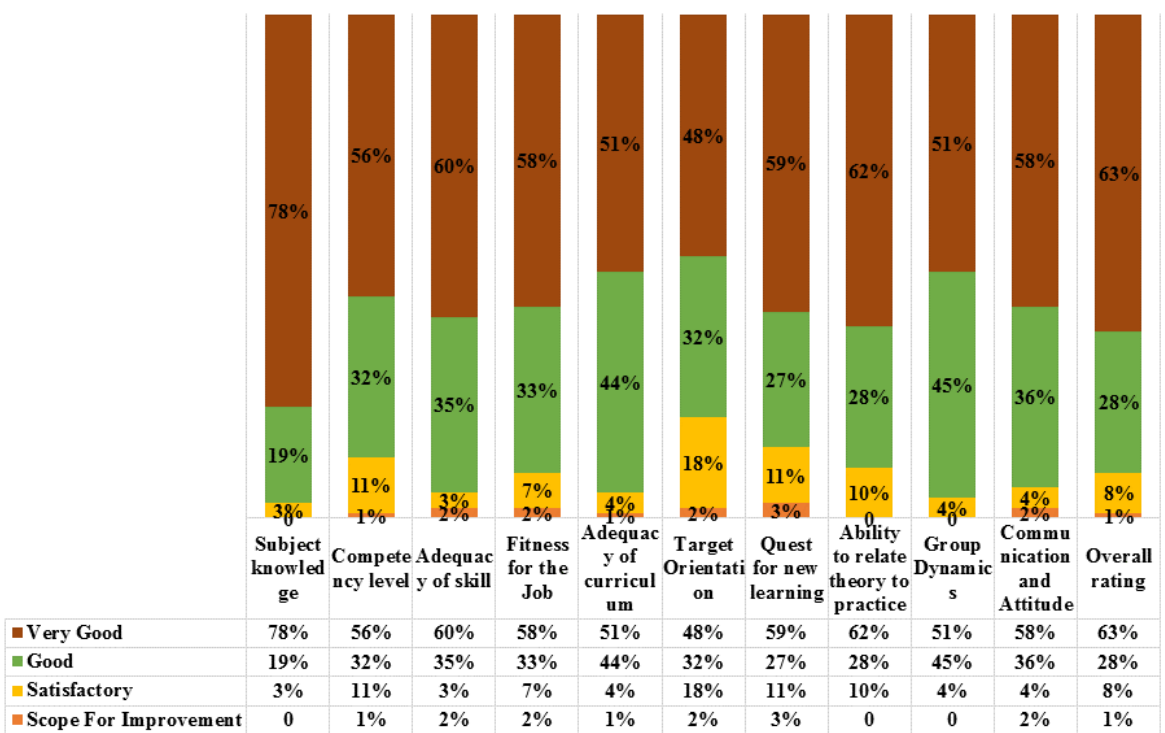

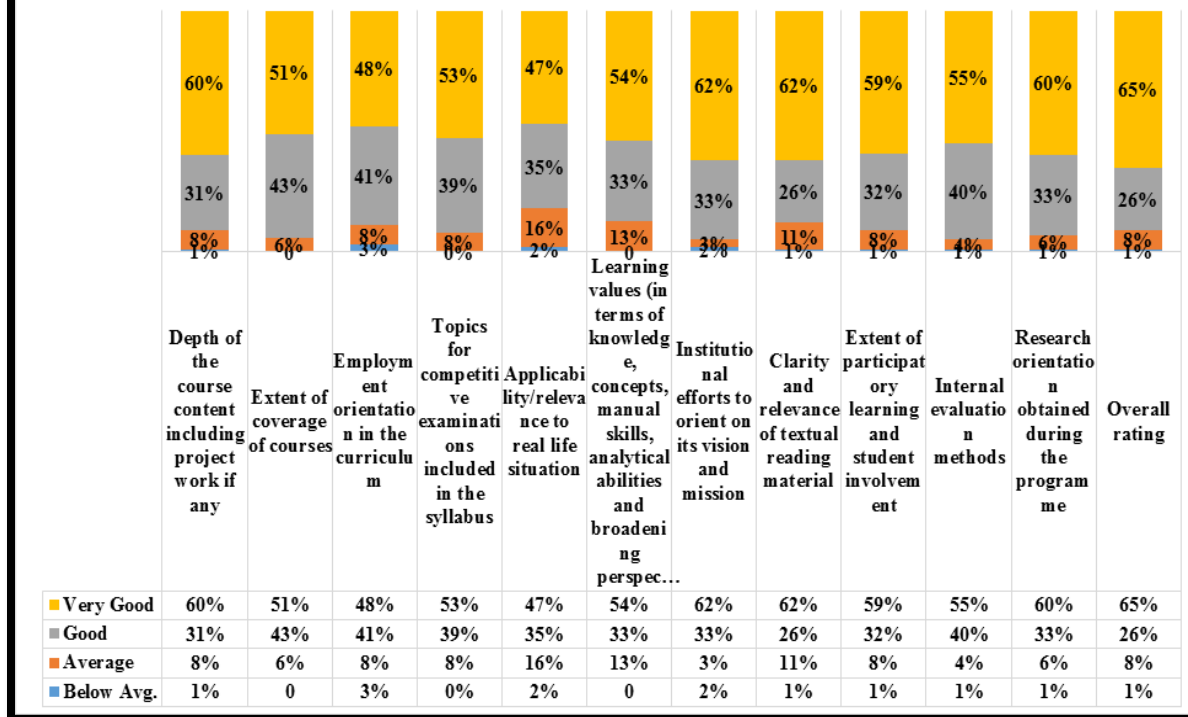
TEACHERS FEEDBACK ANALYSIS 2023-24

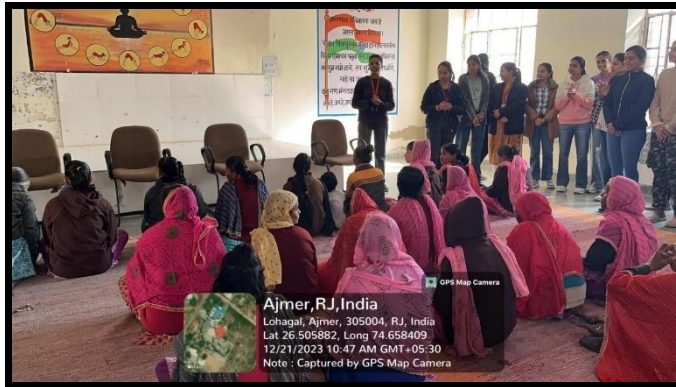

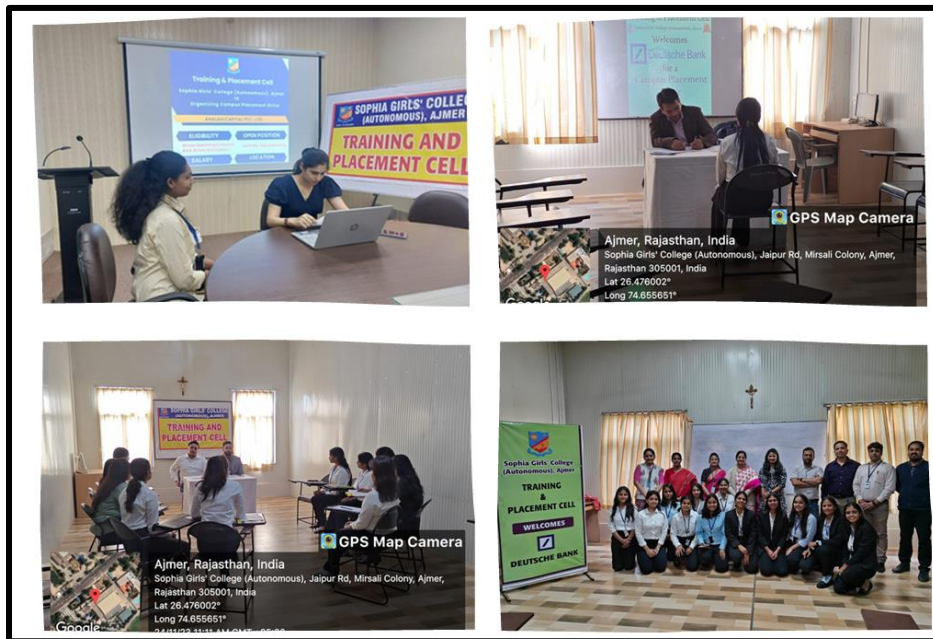

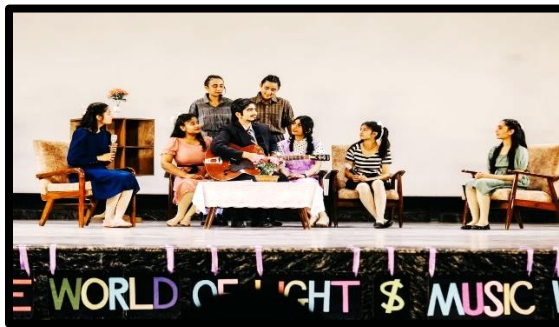

In regular NSS programmes students undertake various activities in the college campus, adopted villages and slums.

- "**Each One Teach One**" activity is conducted in the college round the year. This activity is compulsory for all NSS Volunteers. In this, Volunteers teach the children of nearby Basti who can't afford tuitions. Volunteers teach them for an hour from 4pm to 5 pm and help them solve difficult questions. The teaching activity is not only conducted in the college but our volunteers also go to government schools for teaching. National Service Scheme under Sophia Girls' College has adopted 10 bastis namely Ghoogra, Bunabai, and Kayad. This year, students also went Central Jail to celebrate Rakshabandhan and Christmas.
- On the 27th of July 2023, the NSS Unit organized a **plantation Drive** at Bhopo ka Bada. 47 Volunteers participated in this drive.
